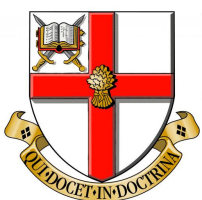
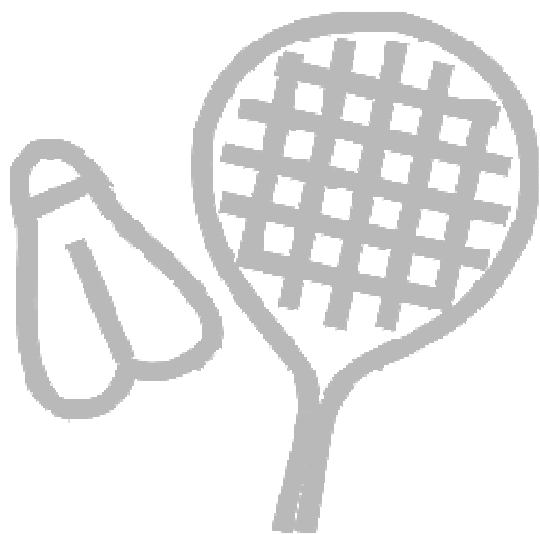

## Conditions of Entry

- Players who have represented their county at any level in the Inter-County Championship (ICC), or have been a member of any National Squad in any country are not eligible to compete in the Festival.
- Players that have played league badminton are not eligible to enter the morning competition.
- Both players in a doubles event must submit an entry form with appropriate fees (photocopies will be accepted). Players entering 'partner wanted' will be paired if a partner and places are available.
- All events will be played in groups with winners going through to a knockout stage. If there is only one group, no knockout stage will be played.
- Unless stated all events shall be one game to 21, with no settings. Rally points scoring will be used.
- In the instance of two teams finishing on the same number of points within the group stage, final positions will be decided on the head to head. In the instance of three or more players finishing on the same points, points scored will be taken into account.
- Entries must be submitted by Friday 4th March 2011 with correct entry fee to the tournament secretary. Cheques must be made payable to '**BADMINTON England**'
- The tournament secretary reserves the right to change any of the conditions above. Their decision in all matters will be final.
- Players must be aged between 16 and 25 years old on the day of the competition.
- Correct clothing and footwear must be worn when competing. Non marking soles must be worn in the sports hall.
- The organising committee reserve the right to refuse entry if the number of entries exceeds tournament capacity.



## NW YOUTH FORUM
